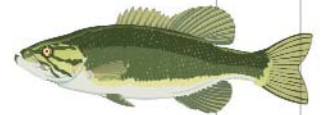
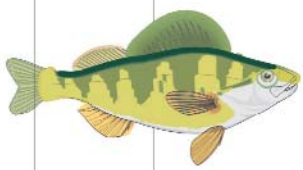

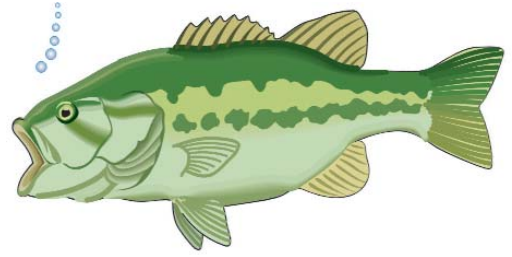

Derby Rules and Facts



- There will be three (3) divisions according to age:

Pee Wee	5 - 6 years of age
Junior	7 - 10 years of age
Senior	11 - 14 years of age
- Contestants must sign in prior to start of Derby starting at 9:00am.
- A \$7 non-refundable donation for each contestant will be collected.
- Each contestant must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Only 1 pole per child.
- Only contestants may cast out lines or retrieve fish.
- Bait (worms) will be supplied at the pond. You may bring other bait if you wish.
- Lures, live, or artificial bait may be used.
- Prizes will be awarded for total weight of fish caught during the Derby hours.
- A prize will be awarded for the largest fish caught during the Derby.
- Food and drinks will be served after the Derby for participants.
