Rules and Guidelines

The Leonard J. Buck Garden is a public garden of national horticultural, geological, and historical significance. Many of the flowers, shrubs, trees, and outcroppings are rare, delicate, and for everyone to enjoy. Please help us maintain the garden's beauty by following these simple guidelines:

- Leave No Trace. Please dispose of any refuse in the trash or recycling receptacles at the Visitor Center entrance.
- Pets—apart from service animals—are not permitted.
- Smoking and vaping, and all active sports are not permitted. These include, but are not limited to: bicycling, fishing, and swimming.
- Picking or harvesting plants and climbing on rocks is prohibited.
- Visitors are not allowed to walk in garden beds. Photographers and artists must always remain on garden paths.
- Picnicking is permitted in the courtyard, the deck adjacent to the Visitor Center, and in the picnic shelter above the perennial border.
- Posed and event photography are allowed by permit only.
- Everyone is welcome. We ask adults to accompany young children.

Masks, indoors, as with all SCPC locations, are still required
