Call 908 766-5955 prior to trailering to the Stable to find out trail availability for that day. Individuals with hearing impairments may use the Relay Service @ 711.

Trail Use

- All riders are required to have an annual Trail Permit or a Daily Trail Pass.
- Trail Permit Fees (per horse):

Daily		Annually	
Somerset County Resident ...	\$10.00	Somerset County Resident ...	\$20.00
Out-of-County Resident ...	\$15.00	Out-of-County Resident ...	\$30.00

- Trail Permits/Passes are purchased by calling the stable office and are valid for one calendar year.
- A current year waiver shall be filled out and signed.
- A copy of a negative Coggins taken within the last 12 months must be provided.
- An ASTM/SEI approved equestrian helmet is required to be worn by all riders while on park property.

Trailer Parking

- **For trail riding:** Trailers for privately owned horses should park in the trailer parking lot on Lord Stirling Road. PLEASE NOTE: Water is not available in the trailer parking lot. There is one optional stream crossing on the trails.

Trails

Monday – Friday 9:00AM to dusk, weather and footing conditions permitting.

Weekends: 9:00AM until 6:00PM, weather and footing conditions permitting.

During the fall and spring, the trails may be closed for deer hunting. Check the website (www.somersetcountyparks.org) or call 908.766.5955 for the hunting schedule.

Trail Rules

1. Ill, lame, or unbroken (green) horses are not permitted on Park property.
2. Only horses being ridden are permitted on Park property.
3. A horse shall not be left unattended
4. Horses shall not be ridden at a gait faster than a canter. Galloping of any horse is not permitted. Riders should not trot or canter down hill.
5. Horses shall be ridden only at a walk when passing another rider.
6. Riders shall stay on the designated trails.
7. Riders may not dismount and walk on the trails except for emergency reasons.
8. Riders may not harass wildlife.
9. It is suggested that riders carry a cell phone in case of emergencies.
10. In the summertime, it is suggested riders carry a fly whisk.
11. A rider is responsible for his/her own safety and for the safety of all other persons using the trails.

General Rules

1. Alcoholic beverages, fires, picnics or camping are not permitted.
2. Pets are not allowed on the trails, with the exception of the FLSS Dog Walks. Dogs may be in the trailer parking areas only and must be on a leash.
3. No pedestrian travel is permitted on Lord Stirling Stable's trails.
